The Center for Japanese Studies at the University of California, Berkeley invites applications for a dissertation workshop for Ph.D. candidates currently working on gender- or sexuality-related topics involving Japan. The workshop will bring together advanced students from Japan, Southeast Asia and the University of California, Berkeley with leading academics to explore topics dealing with gender and sexuality in contemporary and historical Japan.

From Womenomics to LGBTQ civil rights, gender and sexuality issues have become an important domain in Japanese studies in many academic disciplines. Differences across generations, the role of anime and manga in social discourse, gender differences in transnational migration, new LGBTQ family structures and related questions are gaining increased attention in the fields of literature, anthropology, sociology, the arts, history, health sciences, law, demography and religious studies.

This is planned as the first of three workshops intended to foster strong transnational networks in Japanese Studies within Southeast Asia. The workshops aim to involve eight students from Southeast Asia, two students from Japan, and two students from the University of California, Berkeley, and are intended for doctoral students who are currently developing dissertation proposals, conducting dissertation research, or in the early stages of writing their dissertations. Generous funding from the **Japan Foundation** will cover the full costs of round-trip, economy-class travel to Berkeley California, visas, lodging, ground transportation, and a modest per diem. Some meals will also be provided.

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

• Your name, email address, university, and departmental affiliation.

• Dissertation title, expected date of completion, and the name of your dissertation chair.

• A one-page, single-spaced proposal, written in English, describing the dissertation topic and progress to date.

• A one-page letter of support from your dissertation chair.

Application materials are due no later than October 15, 2017, and should be emailed to the Center for Japanese Studies at: CJS@Berkeley.edu. Notice of acceptance will be by November 15. Accepted students will be asked to submit additional materials related to their proposal, research, and writing for peer review by January 1, 2018. Participants will also receive workshop materials for review via email by January 15, 2018.
